INTRODUCTION

In the last 4 years, the Thuillier team has brought a breath of fresh air in the borough of Ahuntsic-Cartierville.

For a second mandate leading to 2025, there is no shortage of projects to implement in order to realize our vision of a green, inclusive and resilient borough that is actively engaged in the ecological transition.



OFFERING INCLUSIVE AND COMPLETE NEIGHBOURHOODS

- Accelerate the construction of family, affordable and social housing.
- Start the construction of an eco-neighbourhood on the Louvain Est site.
- Continue to develop the Cartierville community and cultural center.
- Build an inter-borough library and cultural space to serve the east of Sault-au-Récollet.
- Ensure the redevelopment of the Bois-Franc and Chabanel-Ahuntsic train stations sectors.
- Bring cultural activities closer to the population by offering more activities in parks and public spaces.



CALMING TRAFFIC

- Build at least 100 speed bumps per year on local streets.
- Make the surroundings of schools, daycare centers, daycares and seniors' residences safer for pedestrians.
- Close the Salaberry West ramp on Highway 15 and plan the redevelopment of de Salaberry street with the population.
- Install a noise barrier at the Montreal entrance of the Papineau bridge.



MAKING OUR NEIGHBOURHOODS GREENER

- Plant more than 1,000 trees per year, prioritizing heat island areas.
- Develop urban agriculture and local food sovereignty.
- Improve the green back alleys program and set up a pilot project of "green and sustainable streets".



IMPROVING OUR PARKS AND OUR GREEN SPACES

- Improve pedestrian access to the des Prairies river banks by building the Visitation-Saraguay riverside promenade.
- Continue the redevelopment of local parks after consulting the population.
- Offer new facilities for emerging sports (e.g. skateboard, climbing)



SUPPORTING OUR LOCAL BUSINESSES AND COMPANIES

- Support the transformation of the Central District business district and develop an innovative mixed-use project on the municipal land of 50-150 Louvain Ouest.
- Promote our commercial streets, in particular Promenade Fleury and Fleury Ouest. and improve their street furniture.
- Support the revitalization of Lajeunesse street, Fleury street east of Papineau and boulevards Gouin West and Laurentien.



DEVELOPING ACTIVE AND COLLECTIVE TRANSPORT

- Install a Bus Rapid Transit system ("Metrobus") on Boulevard Henri-Bourassa and redesign this boulevard to make more room for active transport and greening.
- Build a sidewalk and a bicycle path on Boulevard Gouin Ouest in the Saraguay sector.
- Continue to develop a safe cycling network, particularly in Bordeaux-Cartierville and in the Central District.
- Confirm with the Government of Quebec the extension to Cartierville of the orange line of the metro.



IMPROVING SERVICES TO CITIZENS

- Implement a new cleanliness plan and publish the results annually.
- Improve the speed and quality of the follow-up to requests at the 311 service.
- Integrate inclusion and accessibility issues in project design and decision-making.



INVOLVING THE POPULATION

- Continue the participatory budget.
- Consult the population in the development and monitoring of projects, plans and programs.
